<p>This Arts and Crafts style house has a jerkinhead gable roof sheathed in composition shingles. A shed dormer was added at the back of the house and is clad with wood shingles. The primary surface material for this house is stucco. It features an arched entry with a gable roof and an arched front door. A patterned brick walkway connects the sidewalk and the concrete porch. The windows are primarily 6/1 wood and many have fixed storms. The house sits on a board-formed concrete foundation. A deck has been added in the back. The garage is located behind and under the house.</p>
