STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): Peter Smith was a carpenter. His wife's name was Helen. This is the first of three properties the Smiths owned, and it is likely that Smith built the house. The house is a typical Oregon City vernacular dwelling. It has some importance in its association with Peter Smith. In the Canemah NR District, it is classified as Secondary.

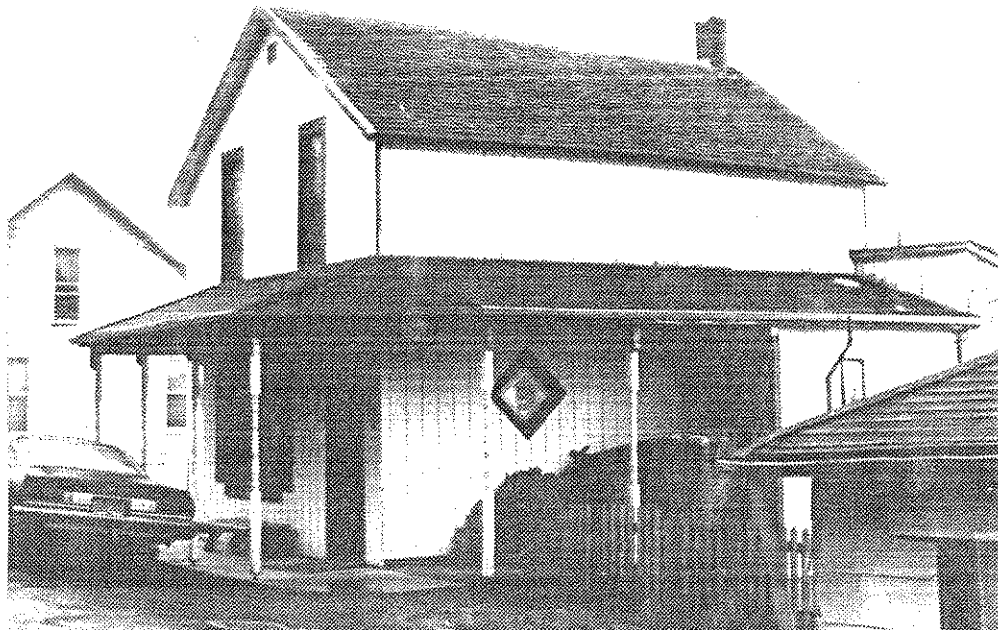

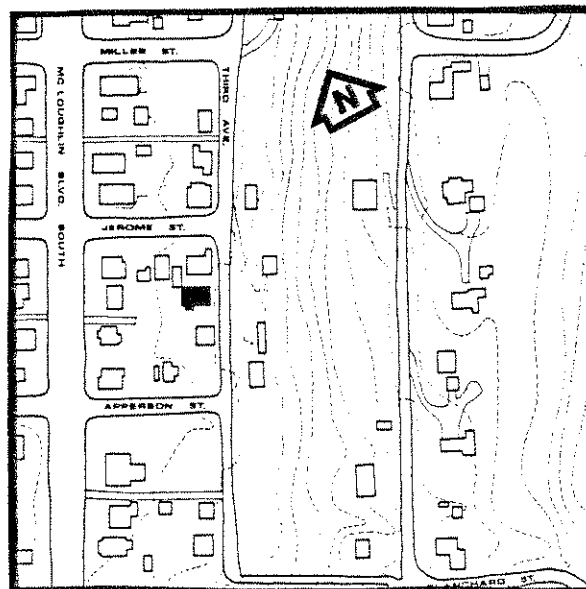
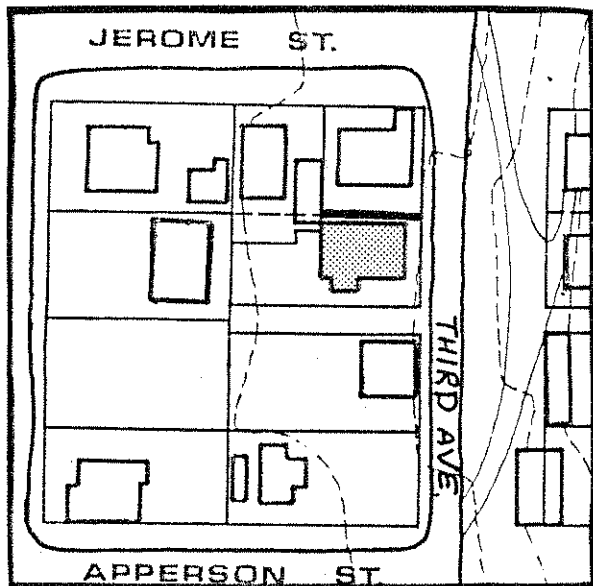
