WHAT'S THE DEAL WITH... | UNATTENDED CHILDREN

As kids begin to develop more independence, they may be ready to use the library or attend a program without direct adult supervision. Younger children, however, still need the support of a caregiver.

Kids age 10 and older are able to visit the library by themselves. Kids age 9 and younger need to be accompanied by an adult or an older sibling/babysitter age 11 or older.

For kids too young to visit on their own, a library card is a great way to gradually take on more responsibility and autonomy by choosing books to take home, using the self checkout machine, and learning how to place holds and renew books on our website at lincc.org.
