WHAT'S THE DEAL WITH... | GRAPHIC NOVELS & TRANSITIONING TO CHAPTER BOOKS

We get a lot of questions about helping kids transition from graphic novels to chapter books. But graphic novels are a valuable tool for young readers, too! The visual elements support comprehension for emerging readers and keep newly fluent readers engaged.

The best way to ensure kids develop a lifelong love of books and reading is to give them time every day to read whatever they choose. And if graphic novels help foster that love of reading, that's a great habit to encourage!

It's also important for kids to read a wide variety of books. In addition to graphic novels, we recommend Graphic Novel Hybrids, Novels in Verse, and nonfiction books to help readers build their stamina—which will get them ready to read full-length novels in no time.
