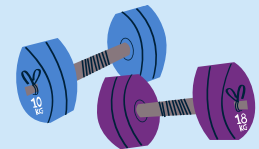
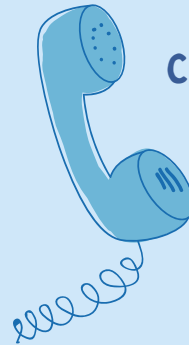

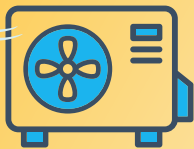

## Summer Climate Support



### HEALTH RELATED CLIMATE SUPPORTS HEALTH SHARE OF OREGON

Climate Support is a health-related social need (HRSN) service and is provided by the Oregon Health Plan. This program is available to members of the following HealthShare providers:

CareOregon, Kaiser, OHSU, Providence.

Climate supports devices to help keep people safe during climate events.

**Members must meet all of the eligibility requirements, such as be at risk for heat-related illness or have a condition that makes climate events challenging or dangerous, be over the age of 65, live in a place with electricity, and can use device safely.**

**Covered devices are only for use in the members home or primary residence and may include the following:**

- **AIR CONDITIONERS, HEATERS AND AIR FILTERS TO PROVIDE CLEAN AIR AND HEALTHY TEMPERATURES.**
- **MINI FRIDGES TO KEEP MEDICATION COLD DURING A POWER OUTAGE.**
- **PORTABLE POWER SUPPLIES TO OPERATE MEDICAL DEVICES LIKE VENTILATORS DURING A POWER OUTAGE.**

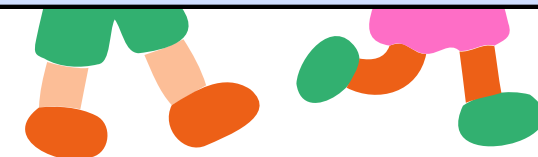

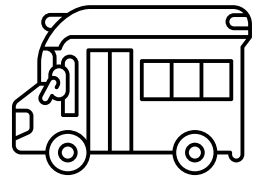
