WHAT'S THE DEAL WITH... | STUDENT & EDUCATOR LIBRARY CARDS

Parents of OCSD students are able to sign their children & teens up for a Student Library Card in ParentVue as part of your Annual Verification. Students who enroll will be able to use their OCSD student ID # to check out up to 5 items at a time, along with all digital resources, with no late fees. Once you've completed the form, your student's card will be activated the following Monday. If you had an SLC last year, renew your card in ParentVue before August 31!

Parents of Alliance Charter Academy students and homeschooled students are eligible for Educator Cards with a letter from the school administrator (ACA) or Clackamas ESD (homeschool). These items come with longer checkout periods to match the length of a typical unit and also have no late fees. Just bring your photo ID and the letter to the Children's Desk to sign up!
