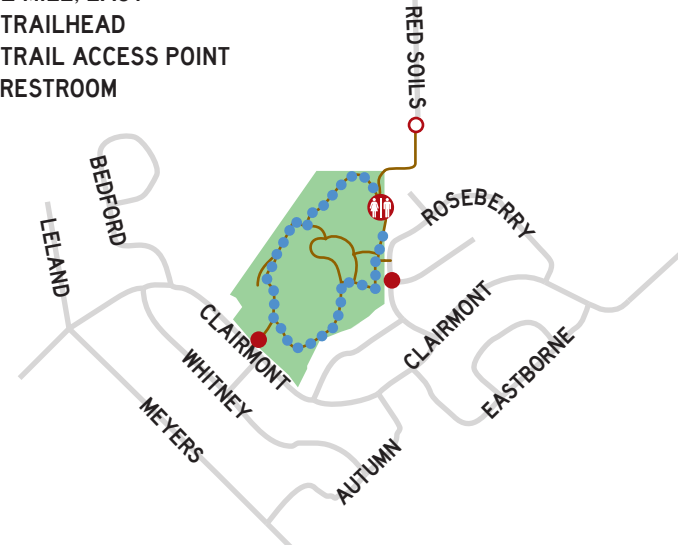

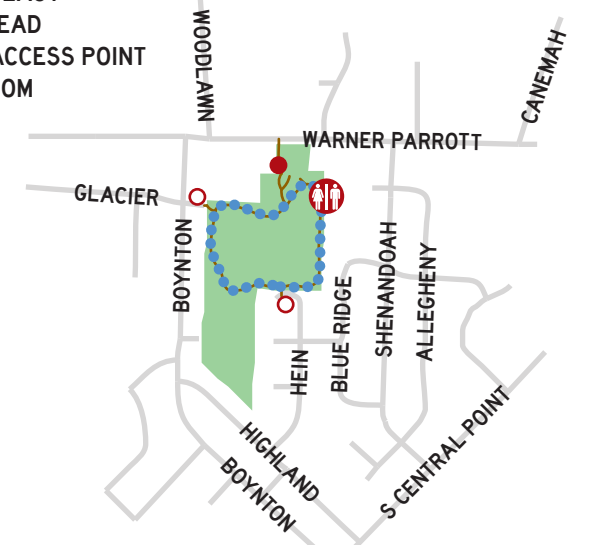

Welcome to Oregon City!

This map offers you the opportunity to explore Oregon City by bike or on foot. Try the suggested walking routes for a variety of experiences. Walks are classified as easy, moderate, or challenging:

Easy Mostly flat, paved

Moderate Some hills or unpaved sections, longer distances

Challenging Hilly, unpaved sections, longer distances

When visiting our parks, please follow the park rules:

- Oregon City parks are closed from 10:00pm to 5:00am. It is unlawful for persons to be in the parks between these hours.
- Pets are welcome, but must be leashed - and please clean up after your pets.
- Alcohol is not permitted in Oregon City parks or on park sports fields.
- BBQ's are allowed in designated receptacles or you may bring your own BBQ. All BBQ's must have at least 8" legs.
- No firearms or fireworks.
- No amplified music or public address systems, except by permit.
- You are responsible for your litter. If you cannot find a trash disposal bin, please follow the 'pack it out' policy. We appreciate your efforts to leave parks clean for others to enjoy.
