

RESOLUTION NO. 21-01

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN AREAS OF OREGON CITY PUBLIC SIDEWALK TO BE USED FOR THE DISPLAY AND SALES OF GOODS AND MERCHANDISE

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code 12.04.130.A. makes it unlawful to use the public sidewalks for the purpose of packing, unpacking or storage of goods or merchandise or for the display of goods or merchandise for sale; and

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code 12.04.130.B. allows the City Commission to designate certain areas of the City to permit the display and sales of goods or merchandise on the public sidewalks under such conditions as may be provided on a regular basis; and

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code 12.04.120.B.7.a requires a business in a designated area that wants to provide short term obstructions for a period of not more than 60 days to obtain a Temporary Obstruction in the Right-of-Way Permit; and

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code 12.04.120.B.7.b requires a business in a designated area that wants to utilize the Right-of-way for an obstructions for a period greater than 60 days but of not more than one year to obtain a Renewable Right-of-Way Permit; and

WHEREAS, Oregon City Municipal Code 12.04.130.B requires a business in a designated area that wants to provide the display and sales of goods and merchandise on the public sidewalks for a period longer than 60 days to obtain a Renewable Right-of-Way Permit and for a period of 60 days or less to obtain a Temporary Obstruction Permit; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to designate certain areas of the City to permit the display and sales of goods or merchandise on the public sidewalks under such conditions as may be provided on a regular basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, OREGON CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Commission designates certain areas of the City to permit the display and sales of goods or merchandise on the public sidewalks under such conditions as may be provided on a regular basis as listed in Exhibit A.

Section 2. That the City Commission, by this Resolution, empowers the City Engineer to issue Renewable Right-of-Way or Temporary Obstruction in Right-of-way Permits for any business in locations listed in Exhibit A to permit the display and sales of goods or merchandise on the public sidewalks with conditions meeting ADA accessibility and sight obstruction codes as described in OCMC 10.32.

Section 3. That the City Commission may revoke this Resolution at any time it deems in the best interest of the public to do so.

Section 4. The effective date shall be the date this resolution is adopted, signed, and approved.

EXHIBIT A

The following areas are designated by the City Commission through Resolution 21-01 for the use of the public sidewalk to permit the display and sale of goods and merchandise:

Main Street: 99E (McLoughlin Blvd.) to 16th Street
6th Street: 99E (McLoughlin Blvd.) to Railroad Avenue
7th Street: 99E (McLoughlin Blvd.) to Railroad Avenue
8th Street: 99E (McLoughlin Blvd.) to Railroad Avenue
9th Street: 99E (McLoughlin Blvd.) to Railroad Avenue
10th Street: 99E (McLoughlin Blvd.) to Main Street
7th Street: Center Street to Jackson Street
