



## Addendum 13: Transitory Food Cart

### Type I Minor Site Plan & Design Review

*This addendum is required for mobile food carts that are located on private property for less than 5 hours in a 24-hour period.*

*The following provisions apply to mobile food carts not located within a building. The provisions do not apply to permanent food cart locations (i.e. pods), indoor mobile food carts or mobile food carts allowed pursuant to a special event permit issued by the City.*

Food cart will only sell food items (food, beverages and associated items). <i>Mobile food carts may not sell cannabis, in any form.</i>

There are other transitory mobile food carts on the property. If yes, confirm that there will be no more than 3 at any one time.

### Wastewater Holding Tanks

Food cart will be connected to individual wastewater holding tanks at all times.				
The wastewater tanks are at least 10% larger in capacity than the water supply tank and are sloped to a drain that is one inch in diameter or greater and is equipped with a shut-off valve.				
Does the food cart only sell beverages where most of the potable water supply is used in the product (coffee, soda)? If yes, is the wastewater retention tank at least half of the volume of the potable water storage tank?
