- Linn Avenue – discussion of varying speed from 25 to 35 and school and tri-met bus stops with nowhere for riders (children and tri-met riders) to wait.

Mountain View Cemetery project updates and accomplishments of Karin Morey presented by Jinny King, Oregon City Parks

- Mountain View Cemetery is an Oregon City Park.
- ADA restroom slated to break ground in 2023.
- Veterans memorial project moving forward.
- An in-person Memorial Day service is being planned for 2023. Flagpole anticipated to be done by the time of the service.
- Most work funded by grants.
- Discussion of honoring Karin Morey who was a historian of the cemetery. She created a database of veterans in the cemetery. The Optimists and Women's Clubs are looking into getting a bench or something similar to honor Karin.
- Discussion about gate versus fence between the cemetery park and Metro Newell Park.

- If Karla is elected for City Commissioner position, she will be stepping down as the President of ENA.

Background/history of Elyville (previously Barclay Hills) with William Becker

- William provided background of the Elyville (pronounced E-lee Ville) area.
- Part of the Holmes 640-acre land claim.
- In 1854 cemetery was dedicated as a cemetery. Elyville was founded by Fred Ely and later expanded as his sons George and Duane opened three stores and started the Elyville development.
