GEOGRAPHIC SETTING: Occupies an interior lot of Pearl Street, west of its intersection with commercial Molalla Avenue. Next door (west) is 307 Pearl Street, another landmark building. Further west and across the street are apartment developments. This section of Pearl Street is mostly residential.
STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: (Historical and/or architectural importance, dates, events, persons, contexts): No biographical information was found on John and Catherine Taylor, the original owners of 311 Pearl Street. The house is significant for its age; extensive alterations make the house less significant than it would have been.

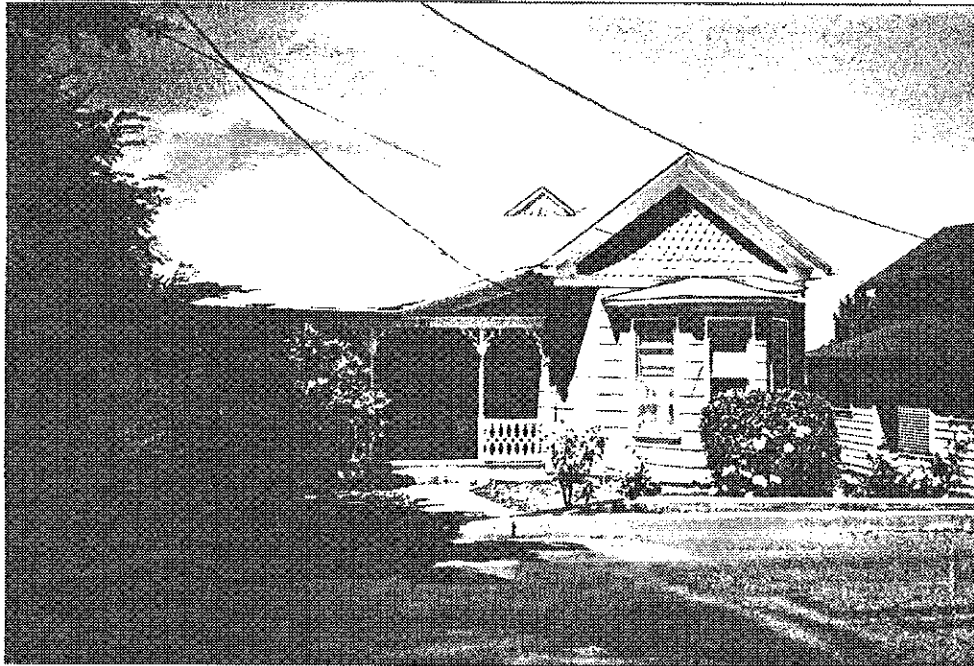

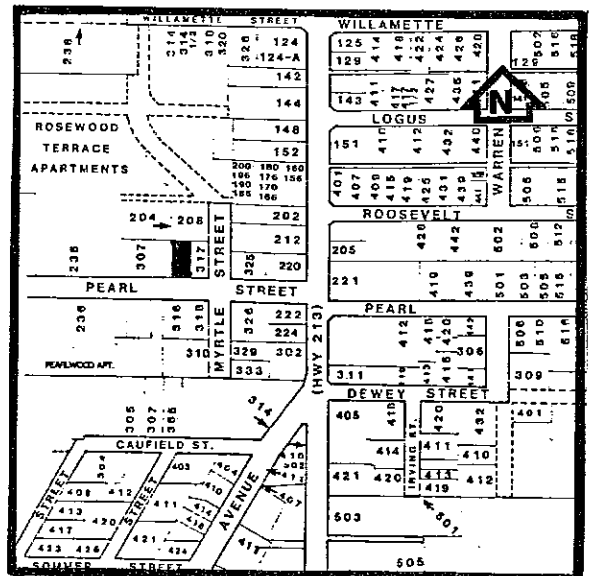
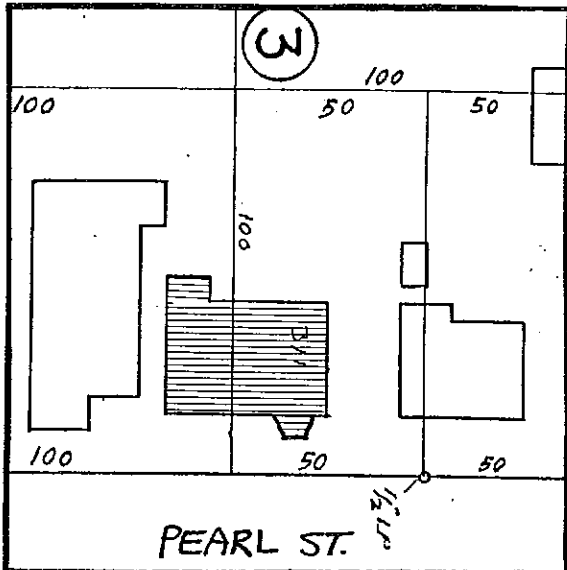
